

# **ACTIVITIES**




### ART - Draw the Friendbots

Author-illustrator Vicky Fang teachers kids of all ages how to draw Blink and Block in this free online video. Watch the video and invite kids to draw Blink and Block.



## STEAM - Explore Bugs!


In the book, Blink and Block are drawing bugs. Find books or videos about bugs and talk about the different types. Invite kids to draw and write about their favorites.



## SEL - Cooperative Play


In the book, Blink and Block have different ideas of what they'd like to do. Talk about how they end up resolving the problem. Why does Block's approach at the end of the book work better than Blink's approach at the beginning of the book? What other ideas do kids have about playing with others when you can't agree on what to play? Put together a list of ideas together.

# MORE ACTIVITIES



## Writing - Create a Friendbot

Blink is silly and Block is logical, but every Friendbot is different! Invite kids to create their own Friendbot and come up with their personality/story.



#### STEAM - All About Buttons

In the back of the book, there is a one-page comic introducing buttons. Read the comic together and then talk about what buttons kids might encounter in their world. For example, buttons on remote controls, elevators, or doorbells. See if you can find any buttons around you!
